At Nibley's Nostalgia Festival, we want everyone to feel welcome, safe, and able to enjoy the weekend. We are committed to making the festival as accessible and inclusive as possible, and we provide a range of facilities and support to help guests with additional needs.

### **Accessible Routes & Viewing Areas**

- The festival site includes step-free routes to the arena, campsites, viewing areas, and welfare facilities.
  - Accessible viewing platforms are available at both outdoor stages, providing clear sightlines and space for wheelchair users and companions.
  - We welcome the use of mobility scooters and powered mobility devices throughout the festival.
  - A charging point for mobility scooters is available on site. Our team will be happy to help you access it when needed.

### **Toilets & Hygiene Facilities**

- Accessible toilets are located across the festival site, including within the arena, Orchard area, and all campsites.
  - Toilets are cleaned and checked regularly to ensure they remain in good condition throughout the weekend.

### **Water, Shade & Rest Spaces**

- Free drinking water refill points are available across the site—please bring a bottle and stay hydrated.
  - Shaded rest areas can be found in the Orchard, providing a cooler, quieter place to take a break.
  - Our Welfare Tent offers a calm space for anyone needing support, rest, or assistance.

## Sensory Support

We recognize that festivals can be overwhelming at times, especially for guests with sensory sensitivities. To help:


- Free earplugs are available from the First Aid Station.
  - A quiet chill-out area is located in the Welfare Tent for anyone who needs a moment away from the crowds or noise.

- Our Welfare Team is here to help with anything from basic comfort needs to more specific support.
  - Staff can offer guidance, provide assistance, or signpost you to the right place if needed.
  - A Safe Point for lost children or vulnerable individuals is located at the Medical/Welfare Tent.
