Terms & Conditions of Entry

We want everyone attending **Nibley Nostalgia Festival** to have a safe, enjoyable, and well-organised weekend.

These Terms & Conditions set out the rules of entry and attendance and help us keep the Event safe, fair, and inclusive for all.

By purchasing, accepting, or using a ticket, and/or by entering the Event site, you agree to comply with these Terms & Conditions.

1. Admission, Wristbands & Entry

- Entry is permitted only with a valid ticket.
- Tickets will be exchanged for a festival wristband on arrival.
- Wristbands must be worn, visible, and remain intact at all times.
- Re-entry to the Event site and arena is permitted, provided a valid wristband is worn.
- Bag and security searches are a condition of entry.
- Entry may be refused at the Organiser's discretion.

Wristbands & Proof of Purchase

Any person found on site without a valid wristband must provide proof of ticket purchase.

If valid proof of purchase cannot be provided, the individual will be required either:

- to pay a charge equal to **double the standard ticket price (£119.99)** in order to remain on site, **or**
- to leave the Event.

Failure or refusal to comply may result in removal from the site without refund.

Access Times

- **Campsite opens:** Friday from 14:00
- **Arena open Friday:** 15:00–23:00
- **Saturday arena open:** 13:00–23:00
- **Sunday arena closed:** food traders, and the Orchard open only
- **Campsite closes:** Sunday 14:00 — all attendees must vacate the site

Please note: security dogs may be used during certain security operations.

2. Behaviour & Conduct

Zero Tolerance Policy

Nibley Nostalgia Festival operates a zero-tolerance approach to:

- abuse
- harassment
- violence
- discrimination
- unsafe behaviour
- serious breaches of these Terms & Conditions

Any individual engaging in such behaviour may be refused entry or immediately removed from the Event site (including eviction from campsites) without refund.

Attendees may be removed for behaviour including (but not limited to):

- intoxication or drug use
- entering restricted areas
- abusive, threatening, or antisocial behaviour
- vandalism or littering
- unsafe conduct
- climbing trees anywhere on site
- breaching these Terms & Conditions

This is a family-friendly event. Behaviour that disrupts the safety or enjoyment of others will not be tolerated.

3. Children, Young People & Supervision

Definitions

For supervision requirements, a child is defined as any person under the age of 16.

Safeguarding and lost child procedures apply to all persons under 18, in line with the Event's Lost Child & Vulnerable Persons Policy.

Supervision Requirements

- Children under 16 must be supervised at all times by a responsible adult.
 - A maximum supervision ratio of **1 adult to 2 children under 16** applies across the entire Event site, including campsites.
 - Parents/guardians remain fully responsible for children and young people in their care at all times.
 - The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry or remove attendees where adequate supervision is not being provided.

4. Safety & Security

All attendees must follow instructions from stewards, security, staff, and emergency services.

Searches

Security checks and searches may be carried out at any time on entry to the Event site, campsites, and arena.

The Organiser reserves the right to search tents, campervans, caravans, vehicles, bags, and storage areas where there is a reasonable concern for safety, welfare, or compliance with Event rules.

Where children or young people are present, searches will be conducted in line with safeguarding procedures, with a responsible adult present wherever reasonably practicable.

Refusal to cooperate may result in refusal of entry or removal without refund.

5. Fire Safety & Open Flames

Open flames are not permitted anywhere on the Event site, including campsites, tents, campervans, caravans, vehicles, or the arena.

This includes (but is not limited to):

- candles
 - BBQs
 - fire pits
 - camping stoves
 - chimineas
 - fireworks
 - flares
 - sky lanterns
 - any similar flame-producing equipment

6. Authority, Enforcement & Confiscation

The Organiser authorises SIA-licensed security staff and authorised Event personnel to take reasonable and proportionate action to enforce these Terms & Conditions and protect the safety of attendees, staff, and performers.

This may include removal of individuals from the Event site or arena.

Prohibited Items

Prohibited items may be confiscated, including (but not limited to):

- illegal substances
- weapons or sharp objects
- alcohol brought into restricted areas
- generators
- glass bottles or containers

- fireworks, flares, or explosives
- any item deemed unsafe or prohibited

Illegal items may be handed to the Police.

Confiscated items will not be returned.

7. Alcohol Policy

- Only alcohol purchased within the arena may be consumed in the arena.
 - Alcohol must not be brought into the arena from outside.
 - Alcohol purchased in the arena must not be taken into other areas of the Event site.
 - No glass is permitted anywhere on site.
 - Excessive intoxication may result in refusal of service or removal.
 - Challenge-25 is in operation — valid photo ID is required.
 - Under-18s must not purchase or consume alcohol.

8. Smoking & Vaping

- Smoking and vaping are prohibited in **The Retreat (Orchard area)**.
 - Smoking and vaping are permitted only in designated areas.

9. Medical, Welfare & Wellbeing

- Medical and Welfare teams are on site throughout the Event.
 - Any concerns should be reported immediately.
 - Attendees must cooperate fully in the event of an emergency.

10. Strobe Lighting & Effects

Strobe lighting, smoke, haze, and atmospheric effects may be used during performances.

These may trigger photosensitive epilepsy or other medical conditions.

By entering the Event, you acknowledge and accept this risk.

11. Workshops & Free Activities

Some workshops and activities are offered free of charge and have limited capacity.

- Spaces are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Attendees must arrive at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start time to secure a place.
- Entry is not guaranteed for late arrivals.

The Organiser reserves the right to manage access, limit numbers, relocate sessions, or amend content/timings where necessary.

12. Dogs & Animals

Only registered assistance dogs are permitted on site.
Documentation may be requested.

13. Photography, Filming & Data

- Personal photography is permitted, but privacy must be respected.
 - Attendees may be photographed or filmed for promotional or documentation purposes.
 - Personal data is handled in accordance with UK GDPR.

14. Weather & Environment

- This is an outdoor event and will proceed in most weather conditions.
 - Areas may close temporarily for safety reasons.
 - Attendees should come prepared for all weather conditions.

15. Cancellations, Refunds & Programme Changes

- Tickets are non-refundable except in the event of full Event cancellation.
- No refunds will be given for:
 - artist cancellations or substitutions
 - programme or timing changes
 - weather or force majeure
 - disagreement with Event content

Artist Line-up & Programme Changes

The Organiser reserves the right to add, withdraw, reschedule, or substitute artists and to vary advertised programmes or timings.

Such changes do not entitle ticket holders to refunds or compensation.

16. Parking

Parking is limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Vehicles are parked at the owner's risk.

17. Wi-Fi

Wi-Fi access may be available on site.

Misuse may result in disconnection or removal.

18. Liability & Personal Property

Attendance is at the ticket holder's own risk.

The Organiser is not responsible for:

- loss, theft, or damage to personal belongings
- injury arising from failure to follow Event rules or staff instructions
- circumstances outside the Organiser's reasonable control

Nothing in these Terms limits liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence where prohibited by law.

19. Lost Property

Lost property may be handed in to the Welfare or Information Point.

Items not claimed after the Event may be disposed of after a reasonable period.

20. Contact & Complaints

Any concerns should be raised immediately with Event staff or Welfare.

Formal complaints may be submitted after the Event via the official contact email listed on the Festival website.
