



## Nibley's Nostalgia festival Code of Conduct

We want everyone at Nibley's Nostalgia Festival to have a safe, enjoyable, and inclusive experience.

By entering the site, you agree to follow this Code of Conduct and all instructions from festival staff and security.

### 1. Respect Others

- Treat everyone — attendees, staff, performers, and locals — with **respect and kindness**.
- **Harassment, discrimination, or abuse** of any kind will not be tolerated.
- This includes unwanted attention, intimidation, physical contact, or offensive language or gestures.
- If you experience or witness any behaviour that makes you or others uncomfortable, **report it immediately** to a steward, welfare, or security.

### 2. Safety & Security

- **Follow all safety instructions** from stewards and security staff at all times.
- **Do not climb**, enter restricted areas, or tamper with fences, barriers, or power equipment.
- **Prohibited items** (weapons, drugs, fireworks, glass, drones, etc.) will be confiscated and may lead to removal from site.
- Bag searches are in operation; refusal to be searched will mean no entry.
- If you see something suspicious — **“See It, Say It, Sorted.”**

### 3. Alcohol & Drugs

- Nibley's Nostalgia operates a **Challenge 25** policy at all bars.
- Bring valid photo ID (passport, driving licence, or PASS card).
- **No alcohol** is to be brought into the arena; it may only be consumed in the **campsite**.
- **No illegal substances** or drug paraphernalia are permitted anywhere on site.

- Anyone found dealing, using, or under the influence of drugs may be ejected and reported to the Police.

#### 4. Fires, Glass & Safety Risks

- **No open fires, BBQs, or fireworks** in any area.
  - **No glass** is permitted anywhere on site — please decant before arrival.
  - Keep **3 metres** between tents in the campsite for fire safety.
  - Know your nearest **Fire Point** and **Emergency Assembly Area**.

#### 5. Behaviour

- Anti-social, aggressive, or unsafe behaviour will not be tolerated.
  - Anyone acting in a way that risks harm to themselves, or others will be **removed without refund**.
  - Please keep noise to a respectful level in the **quiet hours (00:00 – 08:00)**.
  - Do not bring any **offensive clothing, banners, or materials**.
  - Respect the site, wildlife, and neighbours — we're guests here.

#### 6. Environment & Waste

- Help us **Leave No Trace** — use the right bins: Recycling , General .
  - Take tents and belongings home.
  - Traders are required to use recyclable materials — please do your bit too.

#### 7. Welfare & Wellbeing

- Free **drinking water** is available throughout the site — keep hydrated.
  - Visit **Welfare** if you feel unwell, anxious, or overwhelmed — they're there to help.
  - **Lost Child & Vulnerable Persons Safe Point** is clearly signposted and staffed by trained personnel.
  - **Medical** and **First Aid** are available on site at all times.

#### 8. Photography & Media

- Personal photography is fine — but respect others' privacy.

- No drones or professional filming without prior authorisation.
  - Consent matters: always ask before photographing anyone up close.
- 

### **9. Leaving the Site**

- Please leave the site safely and respectfully.
  - Take litter home or use bins provided.
  - Follow all directions from traffic marshals and stewards.

### **10. Final Note**

Nibley's Nostalgia Festival reserves the right to refuse entry or remove anyone whose behaviour breaches this Code of Conduct or endangers others.

Security and welfare teams are here to keep everyone safe — please cooperate fully and look out for each other.
