Our goal is to make sure everyone has the chance to take part, have fun, and make great memories in a safe and friendly space.

1. Everyone's Welcome

These attractions are **free for public use** and open to all ages (within safety limits).

We want to create a relaxed and enjoyable environment where everyone can take part.

If there's **no queue or waiting line**, please feel free to **stay on a little longer and enjoy yourself** — that's what it's here for!

However, if **others are waiting**, please be kind and **take turns** so everyone gets a fair chance to join in.

2. Fair and Friendly Use

Our event team and volunteers may politely **ask guests to move on** if the attraction is busy.

This isn't meant to spoil anyone's fun — it simply helps make sure everyone gets a turn.

We ask all visitors to be understanding and respectful if this happens.

3. Safety Comes First

To keep things safe and fun for everyone:

- Always follow the instructions from staff and posted signs.
- Children must be **supervised by a responsible adult** at all times.
- Please remove shoes, jewellery, and sharp objects before using inflatables.
- If the weather changes or equipment needs a break, attractions may close temporarily for safety reasons.

4. Respect for Others

This is a community space for everyone — please treat others kindly.

- Be patient and respectful of other visitors, especially younger children or those with additional needs.
- Rough play, queue jumping, or misuse of equipment won't be allowed.

- Everyone has the same right to enjoy the attractions equally.

If you're ever unsure or have a question, just ask — we're happy to help.
