



## **Nibley Nostalgia Festival 2026**

### **Prohibited Items Policy**

#### **Overview**

To protect public safety and maintain a secure festival environment, certain items are strictly prohibited from being brought into the arena, campsite, or any controlled area of the Event site.

This policy is enforced at all entry points by **SIA-licensed security staff** during bag and person searches.

The decision of the **Festival Director** or **Security Supervisor** is final.

---

#### **No Prohibited Items Beyond This Point**

Any person attempting to bring prohibited items into the Event may be refused entry. Prohibited items may be:

- confiscated
  - removed from site
  - surrendered to Police where required
- 

#### **Prohibited Items**

The following items are strictly prohibited, including but not limited to:

---

##### **1. Weapons & Dangerous Objects**

Any item that may be used as a weapon, including:

- firearms or replicas (including air pistols/rifles and component parts)
- ammunition
- antique guns
- toy guns resembling real weapons
- knives, machetes, batons, nunchaku
- knuckle-dusters
- spear guns, crossbows
- disguised blades (e.g. walking-stick daggers)
- sharp tools or objects capable of harm
- large metal or wooden poles

---

## **2. Explosives & Pyrotechnics**

Including:

- fireworks
- flares or signal flares
- explosives or blasting caps
- corrosive or flammable substances

---

## **3. Defensive or Control Devices**

Including:

- stun guns or tasers
- pepper spray
- tear gas sprays
- handcuffs
- body armour or bullet-proof vests

---

## **4. Illegal or Prohibited Substances**

Including:

- illegal drugs or illicit substances
- drug paraphernalia
- unidentified powders, chemicals, or industrial acids

Police will be notified where appropriate.

## **5. Items Likely to Cause Nuisance, Harm, or Disruption**

Including:

- air horns, loudhailers, noise makers
- laser pointers or pens
- drones
- helium balloons or sky lanterns
- spray paint or paint products
- large umbrellas capable of obstructing views or movement

---

## **6. Restricted or Disruptive Items**

Including:

- canned goods
- large chains

- spiked jewellery
  - poles, totems, kites
  - frisbees, balls, inflatables
  - banners or placards with offensive content
  - political or cause-related materials
  - country or conflict flags
  - clothing or signage expressing support for any global conflict or cause

## **7. Personal Transport Devices**

Including:

- bicycles
- scooters
- skateboards
- booster boards

**Exception:** Approved accessibility or mobility aids.

---

## **8. Glass & Hazardous Containers**

- Glass bottles or jars of any kind are prohibited anywhere on site.
- 

## **9. Open Flames & Fire Hazards**

Open flames are not permitted anywhere on the Event site, including:

- candles
  - BBQs
  - camping stoves
  - fire pits
  - chimineas
  - fireworks or flares
  - sky lanterns
- 

## **10. Generators & Power Equipment**

Personal generators are not permitted anywhere on the Event site, including campsites, campervans, caravans, vehicles, or the arena.

This includes:

- petrol generators
- diesel generators
- gas or engine-powered generators

**Permitted:** Portable battery packs and power banks.

---

### **Security Screening & Enforcement**

- All persons, bags, and belongings are subject to search on entry.
- Prohibited items will be confiscated or refused entry.
- Police will be notified immediately if offensive weapons, illegal substances, or suspicious items are discovered.
- Clear signage stating **“NO PROHIBITED ITEMS BEYOND THIS POINT”** will be displayed at all entrances.
